The Ashby's visited for the week of March 23 – 27 and in that time period evaluated patients and also provided a lecture on emergency events such as, Diabetic Ketoacidosis, Acute Coronary Syndrome, Acute Cerebral Vascular Accident, Fracture and Dislocation Management and Spinal Injury. The audience was all the physicians based in Carriacou with local nurses and medical assistants. Everyone agreed that the lectures were very informative. With the furthering of our knowledge and confidence in handling emergency situations, this allows us in Carriacou and Petite Martinique to be able to better handle patients who present to CHS, in the clinics and to the hospital and manage them here in Carriacou with out having to travel to Grenada.

Patients seen were evaluated and treated for hypercholesterolemia, thyroid disease, hypertension and diabetes. At CHS, we were grateful for the additional assistance and advice provided.
